ELKIN PET CARE believes the key requisite to successful training is sound physical and mental health. We require that all of your dog's vaccinations be complete and up to date prior to his admission for training. We request that your veterinarian evaluate your dog's health if housebreaking or aggression are issues. Based on soundness of health and temperament, we will assess your dog's suitability for training. Owners must commit to learning the techniques recommended by our trainers by attending the debriefing sessions regularly scheduled with the training and reinforcing principles of the program at home, in order to be eligible for our GUARANTEE.

ELKIN PET CARE offers variety and flexibility in our training programs. Basic obedience can be accomplished either by our well-known, successful BOARD AND TRAIN program where your pet will check into the kennel for 10 days to 2 weeks, or our new, innovative DAY CARE program which provides you with weekly interaction with the trainer over a 3 week period. Your dog will gain proficiency in all the basic obedience exercises, plus work on any problem issues you may be having with the pet. If you wish, you may extend your dog's training period to learn off-lead obedience. Typically, the dog will return home for a week after initial training, where the basics are reinforced and then return to the kennel for the ADVANCED TRAINING. Housebreaking conditioning is available as a stand alone program or in conjunction with our regular training. You may also choose to engage our trainer for individual private lessons if you have specific problems to resolve. Our newest program is for FIELD AND WATER TRAINING for Sporting Dog breeds. We can also train ASSISTANCE DOGS in specialized individual programs.

ELKIN PET CARE is open 7 days a week for your convenience. We are always available to assist you in making your life with your pet more pleasurable and satisfying. We offer special programs for adopted shelter and rescue dogs, and a rebate when follow up commitments are met.
